Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Project involves the undertaking of asphalt maintenance and rehabilitation work consisting of a combination of slurry sealing, patch repair, crack sealing and asphalt surfacing on existing blacktop along Sixth Street between the northern City Limit boundary, not including the intersection of SR32/Walker Street, and the southern City Limit boundary. The project will include the removal and replacement of lane and safety striping within the existing paved roadway prism. This is a maintenance activity that involves no expansion of use. No extended roadway closure activities are required. Safety closures only may occur.
