Project Title: Omega Curves Correction (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. NEV-15291-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at two general curve locations on the State Route 20 (SR-20) in the County of Nevada, State of California. The post miles for this Project are NEV-20 PM 29.7 to 30.9 (White Cloud Curve) and PM 36.8 to 39.8 (Lowell Hill Curve).

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS number NEV-15291-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The Project includes the road realignment along SR-20 at two locations. The Project is limited to improving two non-contiguous segments of the alignment of SR-20 by modifying the existing horizontal and vertical curves of the roadway and adding turnouts. This Project will update the roadway to current standards by increasing the curve radii, widening shoulders to eight (8) feet, adding turnouts for both directions, and improving the vertical profile grade. Additionally, this Project will improve the clear recovery zone by removing obstacles and flattening slopes close to the traveled way. Twelve new culverts and two wildlife crossings will also be installed under the roadway. Excavation, backfilling, grading, compacting, concrete work, and RSP placement will be done in the stream channels and their associated riparian habitat.
