Project Title: Trabuco-Remington Traffic Signal

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Central Irvine Channel, a tributary to San Diego Creek, and the Pacific Ocean, in the County of Orange, State of California; Latitude 33.701178, Longitude - 117.768521. The project is located in the City of Irvine, Orange County, within Township 5S, Range 9W on the U.S. Geographical Survey *Tustin* 7.5-minute series quadrangle topographic map.

Project Description: The project is limited to the reconfiguration of the Trabuco/Remington intersection, which includes the reconfiguration of the Central Irvine Channel, the box culvert and the wingwalls; installation of traffic signals; landscaping; and pavement removal and installation. In addition, curb ramps and crosswalks will be upgraded to satisfy Americans with Disabilities Act requirements.
