The City of Temecula (the City) proposes to create a new pedestrian/bicycle trail extension that would connect to an existing multi-purpose trail along Santa Gertrudis Creek. The proposed extension would connect to the existing trail network at Ynez Road to the east and at Diaz Road to the west, and complete the loop within the City of Temecula's bike path system to the northeast of the proposed trail. After completion, trail users will be able to access the trail at Ynez Road, Jefferson Avenue, and Winchester Road. These access points make the trail ideal for those commuting to the surrounding businesses or simply using the trail for recreational purposes. Under crossings will be created at Ynez Road, the Interstate 15 (I-15) Freeway, and Jefferson Avenue. Keeping the path away from the roadway will maintain the trail's designation as a Class I bikeway and will create a safe environment for users to avoid
