Resolution of Board of Directors of the Biola Community Services District Regarding Energy Commission Energy Loan

WHEREAS, the California Energy Commission provides loans to schools, hospitals, local governments, special districts, and public care institutions to finance energy efficiency improvements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Board of Directors authorizes Biola Community Services District to apply for an energy efficiency loan from the California Energy Commission to implement energy efficiency measures.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Biola Community Services District finds that the activity funded by the loan is a project that is categorically exempt under 15301 and 15304 because the solar sites proposed are part of an existing facility and/ or minor alterations to land.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that if recommended for funding by the California Energy Commission, the Board of Directors authorizes Biola Community Services District to accept a loan up to \$888,128.00.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that General Manager, Felipe Perez, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of Biola Community Services District all necessary documents to apply for and secure the loan for the District and implement and carry out the purpose of this resolution, and to undertake all actions necessary to undertake and complete the energy efficiency project to be funded by the loan.
