Mitigation measures include the following: compliance with the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District's Indirect Source Rule and air quality control measures (Air Quality); pre-construction surveys for species covered under the Metropolitan Bakersfield Habitat Conservation Plan (MBHCP); pre-construction cultural awareness training from a qualified cultural resources specialist and procedures for inadvertent discoveries of unanticipated paleontological and cultural resources, and human remains (Cultural); annexation into the Greenfield County Water District; and participation in the Regional Transportation Impact Fee Program, and obtainment of a street permit or approval of a Traffic Control Plan from the City Public Works Department (Traffic).
