Project Title: Colusa 20 Shoulder Widening Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS No. COL-18358-R2)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located on State Route 20 (SR-20) along emergent wetlands that are ephemerally connected to the irrigation canal (Steer Ditch Canal) that is tributary to the Colusa Trough and the Sacramento River, in the County of Colusa, State of California. The post miles for this Project are COL-20 PM 34.8 to 36.5.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS number COL-18358-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation. The Project includes widening both shoulders along approximately 1.7 miles of SR-20. The Project is limited to vegetation and tree removal, dewatering of emergent wetlands with ephemeral connectivity to the Steer Ditch Canal, installation (trenching, placement, and removal) giant garter snake (GGS) exclusion fencing, excavation and soil importation to construct the expanded shoulders and bioswales, grading of the embankments to create the side slopes, and permanent erosion control and hydroseeding.
