**Project Title:** City of Stockton Bridge Rehabilitation (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. SJN-13513-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The three (3) project sites are located at Bridge No. 29C0157R/L, Bridge No. 29C0238, and Bridge No. 29C0235 where they cross the Calaveras River (29C0157R/L) and Mormon Slough (29C0238 & 29C0235), in the City of Stockton, County of San Joaquin, State of California; Latitude 37.99280, Longitude -121.28710, Latitude 37.94576, Longitude -121.25600, Latitude 37.94548, Longitude -121.27698.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number SJN-13513-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Stockton.

The Project is limited to the rehabilitation of three (3) separate bridges within the City of Stockton. The Project will consist of preventative maintenance work on each bridge, which will involve scour countermeasures, deck sealing with methacrylate, road approach repairs, joint seal replacements, concrete spall and drainage repairs, thermoplastic striping application, barrier rail and sidewalk replacements, and erosion control countermeasures.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, issued this Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
