Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

Description - To allow for the recordation and development of a 17-lot single-family residential subdivision (Tentative Tract Map 18980) with 7,200 sq. ft. minimum size lots, on an approximately 5-acre building site that is vacant, undeveloped, and previously disturbed with an approximate density of 3.4 units per acre.

Location - West of and abutting Second Avenue between Country Ranch Court and Silica Drive just north of the intersection of Silica Drive and Second Avenue; APN:3091-141-02; Within the City of Victorville, County of San Bernardino, State of California, San Bernardino Meridian, Section 33, Township 5N, Range 4W.

The proposed residential development will not create any significant impacts with the included mitigation measures as proposed.
