The City is currently working on the 6th cycle housing element update to cover the planning period from April 2021 to 2029. To comply with State law, the City's Housing Element must be updated to ensure the City's policies and programs can accommodate estimated housing growth need identified in the San Diego County Association of Government's (SANDAG) Regional Housing Needs Assessment (RHNA) allocation for the 2021-2029 planning period. Any future changes to Housing Element policy will require environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). To meet these statutory deadlines, the local Del Mar approval process will need to be completed by October 30, 2020. Per the RHNA for the 2021-2029 planning period, the City of Del Mar is allocated 163 units to accommodate the estimated growth need at various income levels. As required by state law, the Housing Element must identify the City's ability to accommodate this estimated growth through available sites and appropriate zoning.
