The current project will bury the pipelines a minimum of 14 feet below the creek bed, remove the temporary armoring installed in 2018, and reconfigure the project reach of Thompson Creek to match the unimpacted channel reaches upstream and downstream of the area impacted by the 2018 temporary stabilization project.
