**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Phase 1 - Construction repairs will follow the plans prepared by the office of lone Steigler Architecture (ISA) for repairs to the historic Lodge building in Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve. Repairs will include the porch, roof, seismic, beams, wiring, posts, lintels and gargoyles to support continued maintenance and use.
