Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration for eplacement Dedicated-Purpose Pool Pump Motor

Replacement Dedicated-Purpose Pool Pump Motors and Dedicated-Purpose Pool Pumps Appliance Efficiency Rulemaking

Docket No. 19-AAER-02

Project Description and Location

The California Energy Commission (CEC) is proposing statewide regulations to incorporate efficiency standards for replacement dedicated-purpose pool pump motors (RDPPPM). These products are not covered by federal appliance efficiency standards. The required new efficiency standards apply to newly manufactured products sold or offered for sale in California. CEC is also proposing to incorporate existing Federal Appliance Efficiency regulations into California regulation for dedicated-purpose pool pumps (DPPP).

The proposed regulations apply to RDPPM and DPPP, manufactured on or after July 19, 2021. These requirements are motor capability standards for RDPPM and pump capability standard for DPPP and do not mandate any particular technology or component. Manufacturers will need to meet minimum motor efficiency standards and prescriptive motor speed control requirements.
