Project Location: The project is located on an unnamed tributary to Redwood Creek at two locations along Furlong Road, Sebastopol, in the County of Sonoma.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0316-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Sonoma County DTPW.
