Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: To remove the existing single track, 4-span, 59-foot long timber stringer trestle-ballast deck (TST-BD) bridge with vertical concrete piers and concrete abutments and replace it with a single track, 3-span, 90-foot long prestressed concrete box (PCB) bridge girders on two bents. Each bent consists of six steel H-piles. Riprap will be placed at bridge abutments to provide scour protection.
