There would be four new buildings. The Project involves a zone change for a portion of the site from M-G-ES (Manufacturing General in an Emergency Shelter Overlay Zone) to M-P-200-ES (Manufacturing Park, minimum lot size 200,000 s.f., in an Emergency Shelter Overlay Zone), a variance to allow for exceedance of the max. 45-foot height limit, and site plan review.
