Revision to an approved action to construct a new 19,395 square foot building, 65 feet in height to support an existing aeronautics and radar test facility; located north of Wheeler Road, west of Sundown Trail; on a portion of 650 acres.

Review of submitted documentation for the Project concluded that all direct, indirect, and cumulative impacts would be reduced to a less than significant impact with implementation of mitigation measures as outlined in the following sections of the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration: Agricultural Resources, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Transportation, and Tribal Cultural Resources.
