

Plumas 70 Permanent Restoration Project

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO CEQA



What Is Planned

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing a permanent restoration project. This project will repair storm-related damage to State Route 70 at multiple locations (from post mile 0.00-29.9) in Plumas County. The purpose of the project is to permanently restore and replace the storm-damaged highway protective features to prevent route closure and future damage to the state highway.

Notice of Availability

Caltrans and the FHWA have prepared an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND) and Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Plumas 70 Permanent Restoration Project. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the IS/ND and EA and of its availability for you to review. The IS/ND and EA is being circulated for public and agency review in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines. It is available for public review from March 5, 2020 to April 3, 2020.

A copy of the IS/ND and EA is available for review at Caltrans District 2, 1034 Butte Street, Redding, and the Plumas County Library, Quincy Branch, 445 Jackson Street, Quincy.
