Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Potentially significant direct impacts to a Sensitive Biotic Community/Biotic Community of Limited Distribution (i.e. purple needlegrass grassland) and unstable slopes, and potentially significant indirect impacts to specials status bird species, as result of proposed vineyard development and operations.

Mitigation will include i) the reduction of proposed vineyard development by approximately 0.55-acres to increase avoidance of Sensitive Biotic Communities/Biotic Communities of Limited Distribution and unstable slopes, and ii) the replacement of removed purple needlegrass resulting in no net loss of purple needlegrass grassland occurring on the parcel to reduce potentially significant biological resource impacts and geologic impacts to a less than significant level.

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
