INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION
CITY OF SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA**

Project Name: Hummingbird Energy Storage Project

Description: Conditional Use Permit to allow an energy storage facility in an existing approximately 102,462 square foot industrial building with a new approximately 15,000 square foot substation on a 25.33 gross acre site. The energy storage facility and associated substation would connect to the Metcalf Substation via a 2.5-mile-long, underground transmission line within the Monterey Road public right-of-way. No permanent employees would occupy the building.

Location: North of San Ignacio Avenue, approximately 270 feet from San Ignacio Avenue and Las Colinas Lane.

The City has performed an environmental review of the project. Based on the review, the City has prepared a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for this project. An MND is a statement by the City that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the project will include mitigation measures that will reduce identified project impacts to a less than significant level. The project site is included on a list of hazardous materials sites compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the California Government Code.

The public is welcome to review and comment on the Draft MND. The public comment period for this Draft MND begins on **March 18th, 2020 and ends on April 7th, 2020.**
