The project would include various improvements within Caltrans' right-of-way southeast of the Interstate 5/SR 299 interchange. Proposed improvements within Caltrans' right-of-way would include construction of a shared use pedestrian/bicycle path that is approximately 10 feet wide and paved with a pervious polymerized crushed aggregate. Other improvements within the right-of-way would include installation of stormdrain culverts, safety lighting, signage, and bollards at the trailhead to prevent unauthorized vehicle access. Stockpiling may also occur within the right-of-way.
