## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The project is located at the CAL FIRE Blasingame Fire Station located at 23087 Tollhouse Rd, Clovis, CA 93619. Although much of the property could be characterized as previously-disturbed habitat, the lesser-disturbed portions of the project area consist of oak woodland and native/non-native grasses in a rural residential area. The project involves the installation of a DG60-2 Caterpillar generator and a new propane tank to provide electrical power to the facility in the event of a power outage.
