The existing system is currently owned and operated by Cal-Am, a subsidiary of the publicly-traded company, American Water Works Company, Inc. The District's proposed acquisition of the MCD water system would include all associated assets (i.e., real, intangible, and personal property) including, but not limited to: water systems and production wells; utility plants; water rights; water supply contracts; and records, books, and accounts.
