PROJECT TITLE: Custom House Site Drainage Improvements

LOCATION: Monterey State Historic Park

COUNTY: Monterey

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Improve the drainage along the west wall of the Custom House at Monterey State Historic Park to alleviate conditions that are causing deterioration to the stone/adobe walls and plaster covering. Work will:

- Saw-cut and remove a portion of the existing concrete patio along the west and south walls;
- Excavate a 176' x 6" x 12" trench that runs along the west wall, under a garden wall, and terminated at a designated water collection and drain area in the existing garden;
- Install a french drain encased in filter fabric, surrounded by drain rock; and
- Cover the trench, and French drain, with compacted rock to allow for drainage and moisture evaporation.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the minor alteration of existing public or private structures, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; the construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; the minor public or private alterations in the condition of land and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees; and projects limited to maintenance, repair, stabilization, rehabilitation, restoration, preservation, conservation or reconstruction of historical resources, in a manner consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties with Guidelines for Preserving, Rehabilitating, Restoring, and Reconstructing Historic Buildings (1995) Weeks and Grimmer.
