The Perris North Groundwater Monitoring Project consists of development and operation of groundwater monitoring wells in the Perris North Sub-basin. The proposed Project includes construction and operation of 16 monitoring well clusters with up to four wells each, for a maximum of 64 individual wells. Monitoring wells would be located within roadway rights-of-way, or parcels evaluated in the 2022 Revised MND, though exact locations remain to be determined, so potential sites have been evaluated to allow for flexibility. All roadway right-of-way locations would be within the City of Moreno Valley. Exact well locations are to be determined. As such, this Subsequent IS/MND is evaluating a series of street lengths in the vicinity of the preferred roadway right-of-way locations. Two well clusters, MW-14 and MW-16, would be constructed within parcels Identified in the 2022 Revised MND and would not be located within the right-of-way. Wells would be drilled to a maximum depth of between 60 feet to 420 feet below ground surface depending on the location. Above ground disturbance for each well cluster measures approximately 3,000 square feet. Once operational, well data would be collected remotely on a monthly basis, and site visits made quarterly to conduct maintenance and collect samples. Data will be used to help improve EMWD's understanding of the basin groundwater quality and help in making Informed decisions on management of the basin.
