Project Description for the Interstate 580 and Interstate 205 Roadside Safety Improvement Project (EA 04-4J940, SCH # 2020040221)

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to construct the Interstate 580 (I-580) and Interstate 205 (I-205) Roadside Safety Improvement Project to improve maintenance worker safety along I-580 and I-205.
