### **Project Title:**

Waegell's Eagles Nest Tentative Parcel Map

#### **Project Location:**

The project is located at 7266 Eagles Nest Road, at the intersection of Florin and Eagles Nest Roads, in the Vineyard community.

### **Description of Project:**

- 1. A Tentative Parcel Map to divide one 162 acre agricultural property into two parcels. The parcel split will result in the following parcels: Parcel 1: 160 acres (gross) and Parcel 2: 2 acres (gross) with an existing residence.
- 2. A Special Development Permit to allow for the reduction of the minimum lot area for an agricultural property pursuant to Section 6.4.6.I.1 of the Zoning Code. The minimum lot size allowed for a property in the AG-160 zone is 160 acres. The proposed lot area for Parcel 2 is 2 acres.
- 3. A Design Review to comply with the Countywide Design Guidelines.

# Reasons why project is exempt:

It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant impact on the environment. Additionally, the project involves the division of land into four or fewer parcels, is consistent with the General Plan and Zoning, the parcel was not involved in a division of a larger parcel within the previous 2 years, and the parcel does not have an average slope greater than 20 percent.
