

Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration and Notice of Availability of the Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration.

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to construct a soldier pile wall along State Route (SR) 1 in Sonoma County, from post mile 26.67 to 27.09, between 0.5 mile north of Meyers Grade Road and 0.9 mile north of Meyers Grade Road.

WHY THIS AD?

Caltrans has studied the impacts that the proposed project may have on the environment and has determined that with mitigation, there are less than significant impacts. The Initial Study (IS) with proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) is the environmental document that explains why the proposed project will, with mitigation, have less than significant impacts on the environment. This public notice is to inform you of the preparation of the IS-MND and of its availability for review and the 30-day comment period.
