Project Location (include county): The Soldier Pile Wall Project (Project) is limited to substructure rehabilitation at five (5) project locations at Post Mile (PM) 26.67, 26.72, 26.91, 27.05, and 26.79 along State Route 1 (SR-1) in Sonoma County (Latitude: 28.28473, Longitude: -123.1051 to Latitude: 38.28585, Longitude: -123.10255), approximately 3.5 miles northwest of Jenner and 0.3 miles west, northwest of the intersection of SR-1 and Myers Grade Road.

Project Description: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will construct a soldier pile retaining wall and reconstruct eight drainage culverts within their current alignment on State Route-1. New drainage inlets will be installed to match reworked roadway and to accommodate runoff from the increase impervious surface area Back-filled rock slope protection (RSP) will be used and seeded with locally native species.
