Work will include construction of two 12 ft. wide lanes and 8 ft. shoulders (5 ft. paved & 3 ft. unpaved), install center-line rumble strips, and place rubberized hot mix asphalt throughout. The project includes a grade reduction on two short vertical curves to improve sight distance as well.
