The Proposed Project consists of a General Plan Amendment, Amendment to Planned Development (P-D) No. 06, and Design Review to allow for the development of forty-eight (48) residential dwellings on a 2.4-acre site located on East F Street, further identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 064-043-018. Primary access to the site is provided via a private, gated entrance from East F Street, and secondary Emergency Vehicle Access is provided by a twenty (20) feet wide access road connecting to the Foothill Oaks Shopping Center to the east. Access from the project site to East F Street will be restricted to right-in/right-out only.
