
Notice of Intent to Adopt a MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

(Study Results Available)

Stratford Kings River Bridge Replacement Project on State Route 41 in Kings County

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Comments will be accepted from April 28 to May 28. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, to ensure the safety of the public and our staff, Caltrans will not hold any public gatherings at this time and will not offer the opportunity for a public hearing.



WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace the Kings River Bridge on State Route 41 over the Kings River in Kings County near the town of Stratford. Caltrans plans to replace the bridge with a new standard structure. During construction, State Route 41 will be closed for an extended period of time, and interregional traffic will be detoured to State Route 198, Avenal Cutoff Road and Interstate 5.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment, but there will be temporary construction impacts to traffic that may inconvenience commuters. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, which is now available for you to read and comment on.
