
The City of Yorba Linda is the lead agency for a proposed project that is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The proposed project is a request to re-develop and existing property located at 18181 Imperial Highway with a new 3,867 square foot In-N-Out Burger restaurant with drive thru, for property located at the northwest corner of Imperial Highway and Olinda Avenue, within the Town Center Specific Plan (see enclosed map).
