Project Title: RockRose Ranch Creek Bank Stabilization (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0392-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Nicasio Creek in the County of Marin. The nearest address is 2999 Nicasio Valley Road, Nicasio, CA 94946. Latitude 38° 03' 00.7"N, Longitude 121° 41' 32.5"W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0392-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Maja Kristin.

The project is limited to stabilizing the right channel bank of the unnamed tributary to Nicasio Creek below an existing driveway bridge and removing debris below the bridge. Bank stabilization includes placement of rock riprap and willow plantings.
