The complex would include three new concrete tilt-up warehouse structures on one parcel, along with associated mezzanine, office space and parking. The Project requires a Site Plan approval and a Conditional Use Permit for allowing building heights in excess of 35 feet. The applicant may also be seeking approval of a Tentative Parcel Map.
