Project Description: As part of Emergency Notice 2-20EM-00033-TRI, the project is limited to: installation of a temporary stream crossing of Dutton Creek, a Class I stream course, and installation of a permanent crossing with a 18" CMP pipe on an existing landing with a Class II stream course flowing across it.
