The Housing Element identifies and assesses the City's existing and projected housing needs and provides an inventory of constraints and resources relevant to meeting these needs. The Housing Element must also identify how the City will meet its share of the regional housing need, commonly referred to as RHNA. The Housing Element update identifies the potential for development of up to 441 new housing units at full buildout of the city's existing vacant lot inventory. The projected number of units considers development of existing vacant lots and one non-vacant lot under current land use designations and zoning.

The proposed project would also potentially involve updating the City's zoning ordinance projects on APN 068-323-034 at 405 Atascadero Road one parcel to that has at least 20 percent affordable (extremely low, very low or low) units to be approved without discretionary review or "by right."
