## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

This Notice of Intent was issued during the Sonoma County Shelter in Place order. Additional accommodations and digital file review are available.

WHO: Project Applicant, George Young, Permit Sonoma File No. PLP13-0023

WHAT: Request for a Conditional Use Permit for a gas station with six fuel pumps, food mart, carwash and RV storage. The project will be supported by two full-time employees and include two electrical vehicle charging stations available to the public. The food mart will operate from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm, seven days a week. The carwash and electric vehicle

charging stations will be also available during those hours of operation. The project is on a 2.91-acre parcel located at 5300 Sebastopol Road, Santa Rosa, **APN 060-040-033.** 

Supervisorial District 5.

Parcel Zoning: Limited Rural Industrial, Secondary Floodplain, Riparian Corridor, Scenic

Resources, Valley Oak Habitat

In accordance with Public Resource Code and CEQA Guidelines, the County of Sonoma provides notice to agencies and interested parties that it is releasing a final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration IS/MND for the project. The MND did not find potential environmental impacts that could not be mitigated to a less-than-significant level. The IS/MND released by Permit Sonoma is available through the project planner at this time.

WHERE & WHEN:

After the close of the IS/MND public review period, the Sonoma County Board of Zoning Adjustments is *tentatively* scheduled to hold a virtual public hearing on **July 2**, **2020** to consider the adoption of the IS/MND. A final hearing notice will be issued ten (10) days prior to the confirmed virtual hearing date.
