**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT**: Install a new backup generator at the St. Charles Saloon located in Columbia Historic State Park, to provide an ancillary power source in the event of planned and/or unplanned power outages, work will:

- Use a backhoe and hand tools to excavate a 13' long x 12" wide x 24" deep trench from the
  existing 250 gallon LPG tank to the new generator site;
- Install 13' of ½" Polyethylene Gas Tubing;
- Use a backhoe and hand tools to excavate a 29' long x 12" wide x 18" deep trench from the
  existing main distribution panel to the new generator site;
- Install 29' of 2" Schedule 80 PVC Non-Metallic conduit into the trench and pull the necessary wiring:
- Backfill all trenches with the excavated spoils and level to grade;
- Excavate to pour a 4' x 6' x 4" concrete generator mounting pad; and
- Use Hardi Plank cementitious paneling to construct a non-combustible lattice screening enclosure.
