**Project Location (include county):** The Project is located in two unnamed tributaries to Lower Blue Lake and Blue Lakes and along the bank of Blue Lakes, on State Route 20 (SR-20) in the County of Lake, State of California. The post miles for this Project are LAK-20 PM 2.00 to 2.80.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-17734-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The Project includes improving an existing curve at two locations consisting of approximately 0.32 miles, widening existing shoulders, constructing seven retaining walls, and replacing and extending three culverts on SR-20. The Project is limited to vegetation and tree removal, excavation to construct the expanded shoulders, curve realignments, culvert replacement, and grading of the banks to construct the retaining walls.
