Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration. Study Results Available. Do you want a public hearing on changes proposed to Interstate 10 (I-10)?
I-10 Replace Rock Slope Protection Project



WHAT'S BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace existing rock slope protection at 24 bridges on I-10 in Riverside County between Hayfield Road and Eagle Mountain Road, from Krume Ditch to Wide Ditch, just west of Desert Center.

WHY THIS NOTICE?

Caltrans studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show the proposed project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains the effects of the project is called an *Initial Study (IS)*. This notice is to advise you of the preparation of the *Initial Study with (Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration)* and of its availability for you to read, and to offer the opportunity to request a public hearing or to provide comments, and the intent to adopt this Mitigated Negative Declaration.
