The project proposes to rehabilitate and bring to current standards the existing roadway on State Route 184, in Kern County, between 0.1 mile north of Edison Highway at post mile 8.5 and 0.1 mile north of Chase Avenue at post mile 11.6. Complete Streets elements would be incorporated, including Americans with Disabilities Act compliant sidewalks, curb ramps, and continuous bike lanes in both directions, within the project limits.
