**Project Title:** Lucas Valley Road Mile Post 5.08 Curve Realignment (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0437-R3)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Miller Creek, at mile post 5.08 on Lucas Valley Road, in the County of Marin, State of California.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0437-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Marin County, Department of Public Works.

The project is limited to removing, replacing, and extending an existing culvert; constructing a 96-linear foot concrete sheetpile retaining wall; installing two concrete weirs in the channel at the culvert outfall to dissipate flows; placing rock riprap in the channel and the banks; and planting wetland and riparian vegetation along the banks of the creek.
