

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT EA 2020-0002 (Los Verjeles Road Bridge Replacement Project) AND NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE YUBA COUNTY DEVELOPMENT REVIEW COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a Mitigated Negative Declaration is available for public review and a public hearing will be held before the Yuba County Development Review Committee (DRC) on Thursday, August 6, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. or soon thereafter, in the Wheatland Conference Room, Yuba County Government Center, 915 8th Street, Marysville, CA, to consider the following:

Environmental Assessment EA2020-0002 (Los Verjeles Road Bridge Replacement Project): The County is to replace Bridge No. 16C0026 on Los Verjeles Road over South Honcut Creek. The existing single-span concrete structure will be replaced with a new concrete bridge that will consist of a two-span structure with a raised alignment. The bridge is located approximately 4.5 miles northeast of the community of Loma Rica in Yuba County, California.

The Development Review Committee will be considering adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act. The public comment period for both Mitigated Negative Declarations is June 12, 2020 to July 14, 2020.

Any person wishing to testify on the above project or the adoption of the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration may appear before the DRC at the prescribed time and place, or may submit written comments or objections to the Community Development and Services Agency at 915 8th Street, Suite 123, Marysville, CA 95901, prior to the hearing. Copies of the staff recommendation are available for inspection at the same address. Copies of Mitigated Negative Declaration will also be available at the same address during the public comment period. If you have any questions, you may contact Ciara Fisher at (530) 749-5470.

The **Development Review Committee's** action on the project may be appealed by any interested person to the Board of Supervisors by filing a written appeal with the Planning Department within 10 days following the **Development Review Committees** final action on the project. If the Board of Supervisors is the final Approving Authority, or if the project is appealed to the Board, the Board's action is final.

If you challenge the action of the **Development Review Committee** on this matter in court, pursuant to Government Code section 65009 you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the Public Hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Department at, or prior to the hearing.
