NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

Project Title: Freedom Circle Focus Area and Greystar General Plan Amendment

Location: The proposed Freedom Circle Focus Area encompasses approximately 108 gross

acres, bounded by San Tomas Aquino Creek to the east, Great America Parkway to the west, Great America Theme Park to the north, and Highway 101 to the south.

Applicant/Owner: City of Santa Clara / Various Owners

Request: The project consists of two parts: preparation of a Focus Area, to be incorporated into

the General Plan, and the Greystar General Plan Amendment. The Freedom Circle Focus Area would allow, subject to a future planning study, 2,500 dwelling units beyond those anticipated in the Greystar General Plan Amendment, and an additional 2 million square feet of additional office space than is currently allowed under the high-intensity

office designation.

The Greystar General Plan Amendment proposes to change the General Plan land use designation for the 13.3 acre Greystar site from High Intensity Office (maximum Floor Area Ratio of 2.0) to Very High Density Residential (51-100 Dwelling Unit/Acre). The site is bounded by San Tomas Aguino Creek to the East, Freedom Circle to the West,

and Highway 101 to the south.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT DETERMINATION: Based on the conclusions in the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR), implementation of the proposed project would result in Significant Unavoidable project-level and cumulative impacts with regards to air quality, historic resources, noise, and Significant Unavoidable cumulative impacts with regard to air quality (criteria pollutants). All other significant impacts of the project would be mitigated to a less than significant level by the mitigation measures included in the DEIR.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS DISCLOSURE: Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15087(c)(6) and Government Code Section 65962.5, two sites are identified on the California Hazardous Waste and Substances Sites (Cortese) List: Intel Freedom Circle, 3935 Freedom Circle, and Fire Station #8, 2400 Agnew Road.
