Project Description:

Metropolitan prepared a Climate Action Plan (CAP) to outline a strategy for reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions associated with future construction, operation, and maintenance activities. The CAP is a comprehensive roadmap that analyzes historical GHG emissions, prepares a forecast of future GHG emissions, sets a GHG reduction target for reducing emissions consistent with applicable state policies, identifies a suite of specific reduction actions that Metropolitan can implement to achieve the adopted target. On May 10, 2022, Metropolitan's Board adopted the CAP and certified the CEQA document in a public process consistent with Section 15183.5 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

This is to advise that The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California as a Lead Agency under CEQA has approved the above-described project on 5/10/22 and has adopted the following determinations:


- 2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared and adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
