The Proposed Project includes Fire Station No. 1, which will be approximately 16,574 square feet in size, as well as an attached two-story Headquarters which will include approximately 11,353 square feet of space. In addition, the existing storage building located on the site will be retrofitted and refurbished and will provide approximately 3,780 square feet of space to serve as Reserve Apparatus storage for the new facility. The parking lot for the Proposed Project will be located across Water Street to the west and will consist of two ungated visitor spots, two automated security gates, and approximately 54 gated staff parking stalls. This Fire Station No.1 and Headquarters Project is the replacement of the existing facility that the staff has outgrown. The Project proposes a zone change (No. 1301-20) of the site to Public Institution (P-I) to better reflect the existing nature of the land uses in the neighborhood and to ensure that the Proposed Project is consistent with the General Plan. There are multiple parcels that occur on the main Project site and a Tentative Parcel Map (No. 0016-20) is proposed to merge all the parcels into a single parcel.
