The proposed project is the subdivision of those 21 acres into 41 lots ranging in size from 0.08 acres to 0.7 acres. The average lot size is 0.4 acres. Lots 1-34 range in size from 0.4 to 0.7 acres. Lots 35-40 range from 0.08 to 0.1 acres in size. Lot 41 is 0.37 acres in size and will be used for the detention of stormwater runoff from interior roads and lots 35-40. Lots 1-34 are planned to include one single family dwelling (3,400 SF, approx.) and one three car garage (500-600) SF, each, approx.) and drainage detention.
