It revises the land use plan, including some land use designations, acreages, and residential densities, and sets forth development guidelines in the context of 12 planning areas. The new Specific Plan establishes a community vision, context, and sense of place through land use development standards and guidelines that are consistent with General Plan goals and policies. The plan coordinates various aspects of sustainability, infrastructure planning, infill development, and lot consolidation, where appropriate.
