The proposed project would expand the existing dairy beyond its current permitted capacity so that the modified dairy would house 2,500 milk cows, 500 dry cows, and 2,950 support stock. This would represent an increase of 1,300 animals from existing numbers. The project would include construction of approx. 375,500 sq ft of new structures; 42,440 sq ft of structures would be removed. Approximately 14 acres of cropped acreage would be converted to active dairy facilities.
